DEEP ADAPTATION: A Map for Navigating Climate Tragedy

“Professor Jem Bendell of Cumbria University in the UK has been exploring how human society will adapt to the existential crisis that climate change is posing to our world as we fail to keep global warming below 2 degrees C.

He proposes a program of Deep Adaptation based on three approaches:

Resilience—is the process of adapting well in the face of adversity, trauma, tragedy, threats or significant sources of stress, involving the creative reinterpretation of identity and priorities.

Relinquishment—is people and communities letting go of certain assets, behaviors and beliefs where retaining them could make matters worse.

Restoration—is people and communities rediscovering attitudes and approaches to life and organization that our hydrocarbon-fueled civilization eroded.”
